Since 1999, House of Friendship has partnered with the Sunnydale Community Association (SCA) and Waterloo Region Housing to operate the Sunnydale Community Centre. The goal of this program is to improve the quality of life and well-being of the residents of this neighbourhood.

Sunnydale Community Centre is situated in a culturally diverse community and is home to many new immigrant families, a large number of children and youth, and many living on a limited income. Despite the many challenges faced by its residents, the Sunnydale community celebrates and builds on its strengths.
